Approval of Minutes

Trustee Lou Monville called the Committee on Collective Bargaining to order. The minutes of the January 26, 2010, meeting were approved as submitted.

Approval of Initial Proposals for Bargaining With the Academic Professionals of California (Unit 4)

There was one action item adopted by the committee, the CSU's initial proposals for successor contract bargaining with the Academic Professionals of California (APC).

CSUEU President Pat Gantt addressed the committee and expressed his concern about the layoffs at East Bay, the Chancellor's Office and Humboldt. He highlighted CSUEU's efforts to restore the CSU's declining general fund budget and re-iterated CSUEU's commitment to work with the University to mitigate as many layoffs as possible.

Chair Monville adjourned the committee.
