Bystander Intervention Strategies- The 5 Ds

DIRECT- Confront the situation. Be firm, clear, and concise. Say or do something.

DISTRACT – De-escalate the situation. Move attention away.

DELEGATE – Seek help from a third party.

DELAY – Check in with the person being harassed. Offer support.

DOCUMENT - Document the incident.
