#### WHAT IS SCCWRP?

- Joint Powers Agency founded in 1969
- Our mission: Provide an unbiased scientific foundation for ambient water quality management in California
  - We don't do policy
  - We don't do regulation
  - However, we judge success on whether our science is being used by those who do policy and regulation
- Diverse membership
  - Member organizations include city, county, state, and federal agencies
  - Unique combination of regulators and dischargers

# SCCWRP COMMISSION

- Governing board that includes leaders from each member agency
  - Meets quarterly
- They are supported by the Commission's Technical Advisory Group
  - Lead scientists from each member agency
  - They meet eight times per year and help guide our research priorities
  - They also serve as our primary point of intersection for technology transfer
- The Commission and CTAG provide a powerful interface between science and management
  - The real strength of the organization

## **ORGANIZATIONAL SIZE**

#### 50 full-time staff

28 of whom have a Ph.D.

#### Almost all our projects are conducted collaboratively

- Partners add to and diversify our scientific thought process
- They are also critical to achieving scientific consensus
- We published scientific papers with 188 other institutions in the last year alone

#### We have a 27,000 square foot facility

- Four conference rooms with high-end video hosting capacity
- 10,000 sq. feet of laboratory space with specialized chemistry, toxicology and molecular capacity

#### WHY IS SCCWRP AT YOUR MEETING?

- Steve Blumenshine and I agreed there is potential synergy
- You have skill sets we do not (or not enough of)
  - Social science
  - Economics
  - Stormwater engineering
- We bring a connection to the management community
  - Helping focus your research on things they want to know about
  - A forum for communicating your findings
  - Context for some of their funding calls
- We also hire
  - Quite a few of our part-time employees (interns) come from CSU
  - Most of our full-time hires start with word-of-mouth
