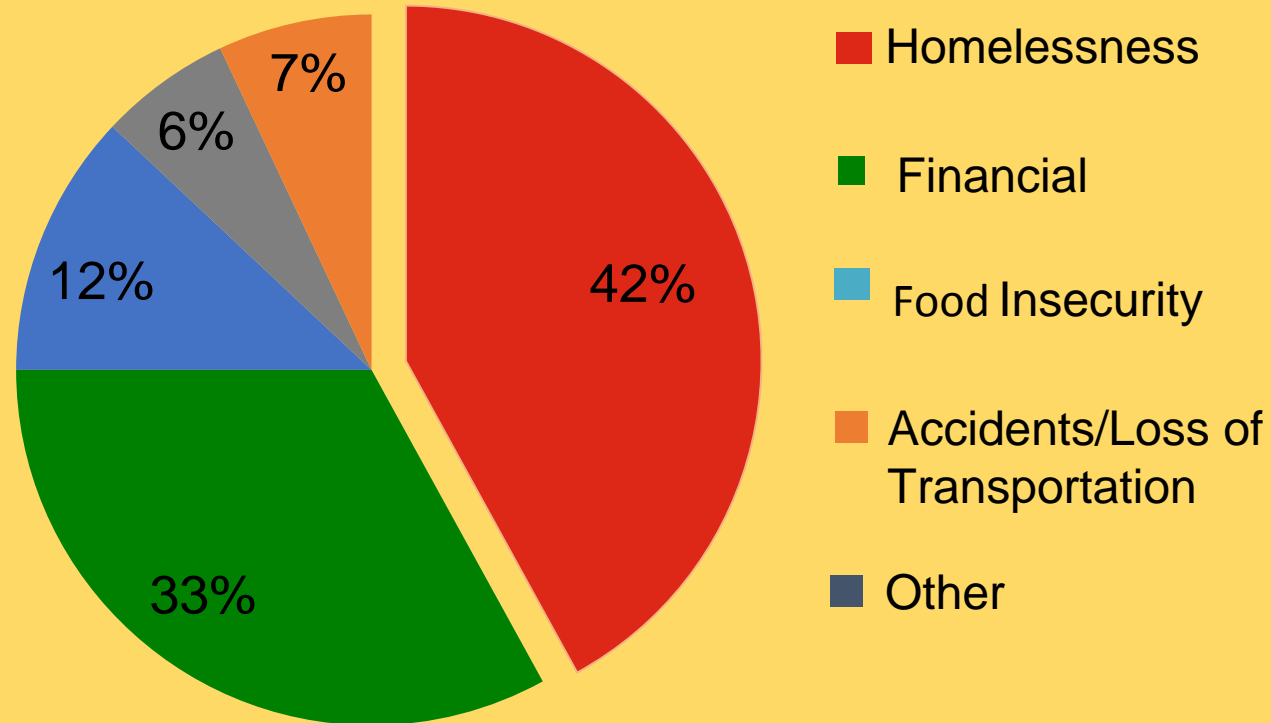

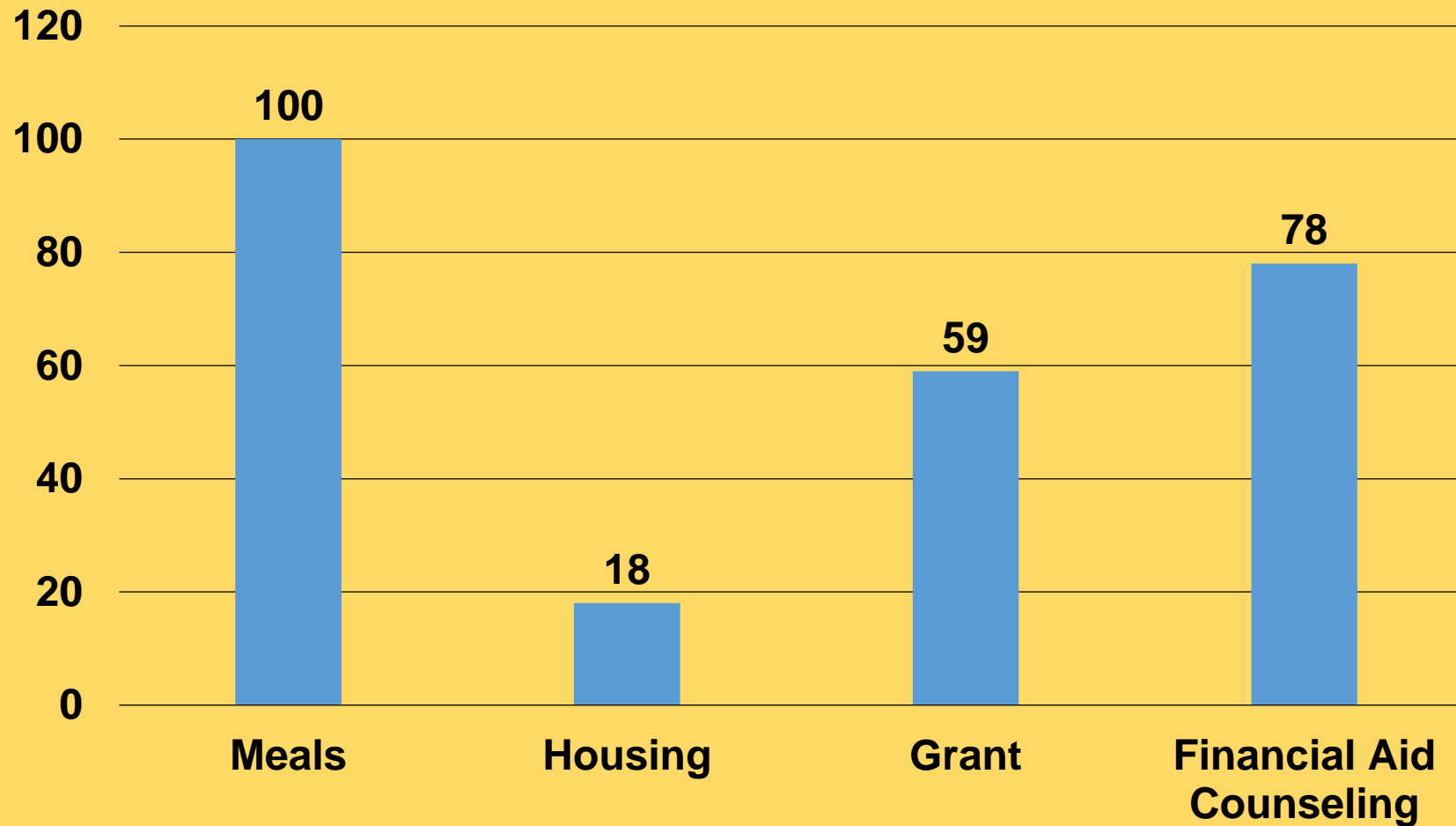
- Students in crisis or an unforeseen emergency

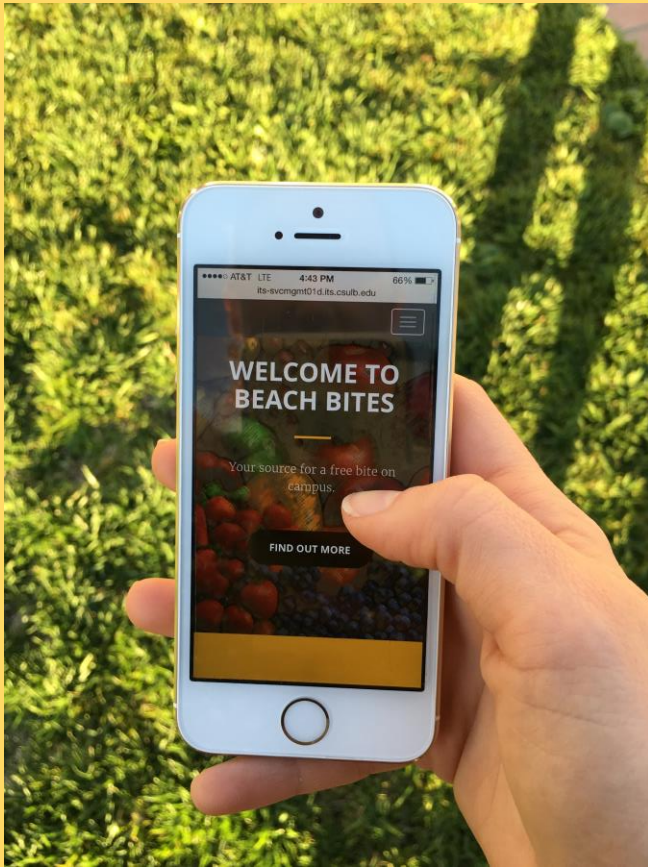

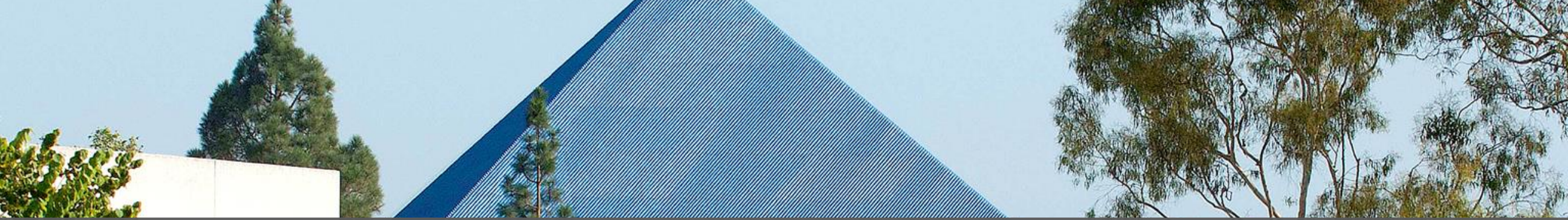


BeachBites
