Given the California Department of Education's *Global California 2030* initiative, The California State University system develops teachers who can prepare public school children and youth to participate, and lead, in a multicultural, multilingual society. California's Commission on Teacher Credentialing allows educators wishing to provide multilingual instruction to English Learners (ELs) to add Bilingual Authorizations to valid California teaching credentials. CSU campuses offer Bilingual Authorization in English plus the following languages: Arabic, Armenian, Cantonese, Filipino, Hmong, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Mandarin, Portuguese, Punjabi, Spanish, and Vietnamese.
